The Kiwanis Club of Simi Valley and the Simi Valley Days Foundation invite you to participate in **SIMI VALLEY DAYS 2009**. The Simi Valley Days Carnival will run from **Wednesday, September 9 through Sunday, September 13, 2009**. For the second year we will be at the beautiful Rancho Simi Community Park, in the center of Simi Valley, at Royal Ave. and Erringer Rd. Simi Valley Days is a great opportunity to raise funds for non-profit organizations and profits for professional food vendors. The price of booths/trailer space is as follows:

Non-Profit Game Booth	\$150.00
Non-Profit Food Booth - 10' x 12' booth	\$170.00
Non-Profit Food Trailer	\$350.00
Professional Food Booth - 10' x 12' booth	\$520.00
Professional Food Trailer	\$550.00

The above charges include the cost of the booth/space, 110 volt, 20 amp electricity, water and utensil washing facilities. 220 volt, single phase power requirements can be accommodated for an additional charge.

All applicants are encouraged to attend an organizational and planning meeting on Monday, August 24, 2009, at 7:00 pm at Rancho Simi Community Park to discuss important details of the event. The park is at Erringer Rd. and Royal Ave. and we will meet at the picnic pavilion.

Ventura County Environmental Health requires that Temporary Food Facility applications be submitted by the organizer two weeks prior to the event. Therefore, all food vendors must submit their TFF application, along with their Vendor Application, Certificate of Insurance and check, to the SVD Food Vendor Committee by August 21. Temporary Food Facility Application forms and Training are available on the Ventura County Environmental Health website. If you have completed the training the health permit fee is waived for non-profit vendors and the for-profit vendor's fee is reduced by 50%. You can access their website at www.ventura.org/envhealth, and then click on "programs", then "Temporary Food Facility Training" for the training program or "Consumer Food Protection", then "Community Events/Temp Food Facilities" for a health permit application. Also, all professional food vendors must have a City of Simi Valley Business Tax Receipt before you may open for business.
